

How to download file via BT Torrent on Router?

It is suitable for: A5004NS

Application introduction:

The A5004NS provides a USB 3.0 port that supports Torrent function to make file downloading more easy without PC.

STEP-1:

Before using this function, please make sure you have connected to the Internet.

STEP-2:

Log into the Web page, choose *Advanced Setup ->USB Storage ->Service Setup*. Click *Torrent*.

Remote ID: define the ID for opening the torrent file.*Remote Password:* enter the password to open the Torrent file.*Download Folder:* choose the path on USB storage to store the file.
