Application:

By port forwarding, the data for Internet applications can pass through the firewall of the router or gateway. This article will show you how to forward ports on your router.

STEP-1: Connect your computer to the router

- 1-1. Connect your computer to the router by cable or wireless, then login the router by entering http://192.168.1.1 into the address bar of your browser.
 - ← → C ③ 192.168.1.1

Note: The default IP address of TOTOLINK router is 192.168.1.1, the default Subnet Mask is 255.255.255.0. If you can't log in, Please restore factory settings.

1-2. Please click Setup Tool icon



to enter the router's setting interface.



1-3. Please login to the Web Setup interface (the default user name and password is **admin**).
